Who I am

Every man and woman is made in God's image.

Genesis 1:27 *So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.*

1 John 3:1 *See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are!*

Ephesians 1:5 *God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure.*

Galatians 4:6 *And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." (Note: "Abba" means we call him "dad")*

Isaiah 41:13 *For I hold you by your right hand—I, the Lord your God. And I say to you, ‘Don’t be afraid. I am here to help you.’*

Joshua 1:9 *This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”*

2 Timothy 1:7 *For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.*

Jeremiah 29:11 *For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.*

Isaiah 49:15-16 *Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for the child she has borne? But even if that were possible, I would not forget you! 16 See, I have written your name on the palms of my hands.*

God knows the exact number of hairs on my head.

Luke 12:7 *The very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don’t be afraid.*
